

ANCIENT EGYPT: BEAUTY & FASHION

MAKEOVER



TO DO:

Create bust of female Pharaoh (head & shoulders)

For head use polystyrene skull as base or make one from scrunched up tinfoil.

Use a sturdy tube for neck and attach to head.

Pad out shoulders and chest with foil (this will save you having to use a lot of plasticine)
Cover with plasticine (Newplast 'terracotta' is a perfect colour).

Add eyes , ears , nose , mouth, eyebrows.

Either make a crown from card (as above) or a wig from black wool (which you could plait).



Make a jewelled collar, earrings

Use shiny card, beads, wire

Prepare 'make up' (don't apply it yet - wait until you animate!)

- Black plasticine that you can add in small sections for the kohl eyeliner

- Crushed up chalk pastels that you can brush on:

blue / green for eyeshadow (add a small amount of glitter to make it sparkle)

red/brown for blusher

- Red plasticine for replacement lips

Make 2 sets of eyelids

One set skin colour , the other in your eyeshadow colour

Write a script for your makeover or makeup advert

Include interesting info about what the Ancient Egyptians used and why, e.g. kohl, red ochre, malachite etc.

Animate your makeover or makeup advert

TOP TIP! Take at least 12 frames when you have completed one section (e.g. one eye with eyeshadow) to make sure that your animation doesn't go too quickly.

Animating blinks also helps with this. A cheeky wink or pout of the lips is a fun touch.

Record your voiceover and add to your animation

You may need to make adjustments to make it fit.
